



Bartimaeus and Zacchaeus

II Corinthians 5:14 What urges the apostles on?
For how many did Jesus die? If all have died, is this referring to a physical death or
is there another meaning? See verse 15
Verse 15 On the basis of Jesus' death for them, how might the living now live their lives?
Verse 16 It is easy to look at a person walking around and think of them simply as another human being
who was born, will live and then die. Is this the way Paul has come to see them? Did
he once see Jesus as simply human?
Something happened. Does Paul now see Jesus as simply a human being?
Verse 17 Here we run into the phrase "in Christ". What does Paul call a person who is "in Christ"?
What has passed away?
What is there now?
Verse 18 If one is a new creation, who made that happen?
Who took action to reconcile us to God? By what means or through whom did
reconciliation take place?
Out of this, what ministry has Paul now been given?
Verse 19 God chose to reconcile the world to himself. Through whom was this reconciliation
accomplished?
What now happens to the sins people commit?



Even if this reconciliation with God was accomplished, would anyone know what God did if they never
heard about it? To whom is the message of this reconciliation entrusted?
Verse 20 What new word comes up in this verse describing the work Paul and others are doing?
If an ambassador goes to another country representing his or
her own country, who then is Paul representing?
Who is making his appeal through Paul? On behalf of whom is Paul sharing?
What request does he make?
Verse 21 For whose sake did God make Jesus to be sin? Did Jesus live a sinful life? How
could it be that we sinners could now obtain the righteousness of God?
Colossians 2:12 What happens when a person is baptized?
What happens when we have faith in God?
What did God do?
Verse 13 What happens to a person who is dead in trespasses?
What did God forgive?
Verse 14 What did God erase?
What did God nail to the cross?
Verse 15 Who did God disarm?
How did he make them look?
Who won?
